



# Festival of Arts Scholarship 2012-2013

## Instructions and Requirements for Scholarship Fields

### Film

- Submit a DVD with your application containing three (3) recent short segments of films you have produced.
- Total playing time may not exceed 15 minutes. Be prepared to introduce each segment at your interview.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**

### Performing Arts

Dance, Music, and Theater Arts are included. Auditions may include one or all of the following areas: Dance, Music and Theater Arts.

During March, you will be notified of the exact date of the audition and interview.

**Performing Arts auditions will be held the week of April 23, 2012. Subject to change.**

#### **Audition Requirements: Dance**

- Bring any needed accompaniment including music along with playback equipment.
- Candidates may audition solo, pas de deux, or with a group, and are encouraged to perform their own choreography.
- Two different dance performances in contrasting styles and tempo.
- A solo.

#### **Audition Requirements: Music**

##### **Vocal and Instrumental:**

- Present three (3) selections of contrasting styles, not to exceed ten minutes.
- Submit sheet music for each selection. Do not staple or tape together.
- Candidates may provide their own accompanist, or a piano accompanist is available for those needing one. Whether or not you will need an accompanist must be indicated on your application.
- Vocalists may use a microphone.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**
- Evaluation based on: tone (beauty, control, production), interpretation (tempo, expression, phrasing), accuracy, technique, stage presence, and suitability of selections for audition.

##### **Composition:**

- Must submit three (3) pieces of recent original work on a CD.
- Submit a full transcription of each piece into sheet music.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**

#### **Audition Requirements: Theater Arts Performance**

- Perform two contrasting selections, each three to four minutes in length.
- Scene partner and props may be used.
- Monologues from an audition book are not permitted.

#### **Production**

- **Stage Design**  
Design and submit a scale model set and provide a drawing related to a play of the candidate's choice.
- **Lighting**  
Design and submit a lighting plot and drawing showing lighting related to a play of the candidate's choice.
- **Costuming**  
Design and submit costume designs with fabric samples related to a play of the candidate's choice.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**

### Visual Arts

- Deliver six (6) examples of original artwork to the Festival of Arts office.
- 2-D and 3-D artwork including: ceramics, digital art, fabric, glass, graphics, jewelry, mixed-media, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, watercolor and handcrafted wood may be submitted.
- Label all artwork submitted (including portfolio cases and bases) with your printed name, school and date. Artwork should be labeled on the reverse or bottom of the submitted work.
- It is to your advantage to have 2-D work matted, framed, or otherwise professionally presented.
- 2-D artwork should be brought to the FOA in a portfolio case. 3-D work should utilize bases and stands.
- Be prepared to take your artwork home with you at the completion of your interview.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**
- Evaluation based on: use of material; technique; understanding of form, color, design, subject and composition; presentation.

The Festival of Arts offices are open Monday to Friday, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. When you deliver your artwork, please select an available interview time on the scholarship interview schedule sheet located at the reception desk.

### Writing

- A portfolio of at least three samples of recent original work, totaling 500 - 1,500 words.
- All work must be typewritten and double-spaced. Each page should have adequate margins, and candidate's name and date of creation should appear at the top right of each page.
- Submit your portfolio in Word Format (word.doc) via e-mail (scholarships@foapom.com) or on a CD.
- **Deadline: Before 4 p.m. on Friday, March 16, 2012.**
